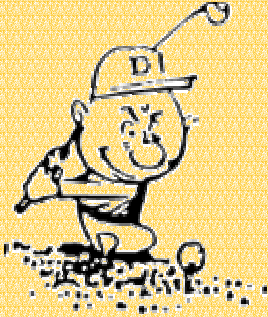

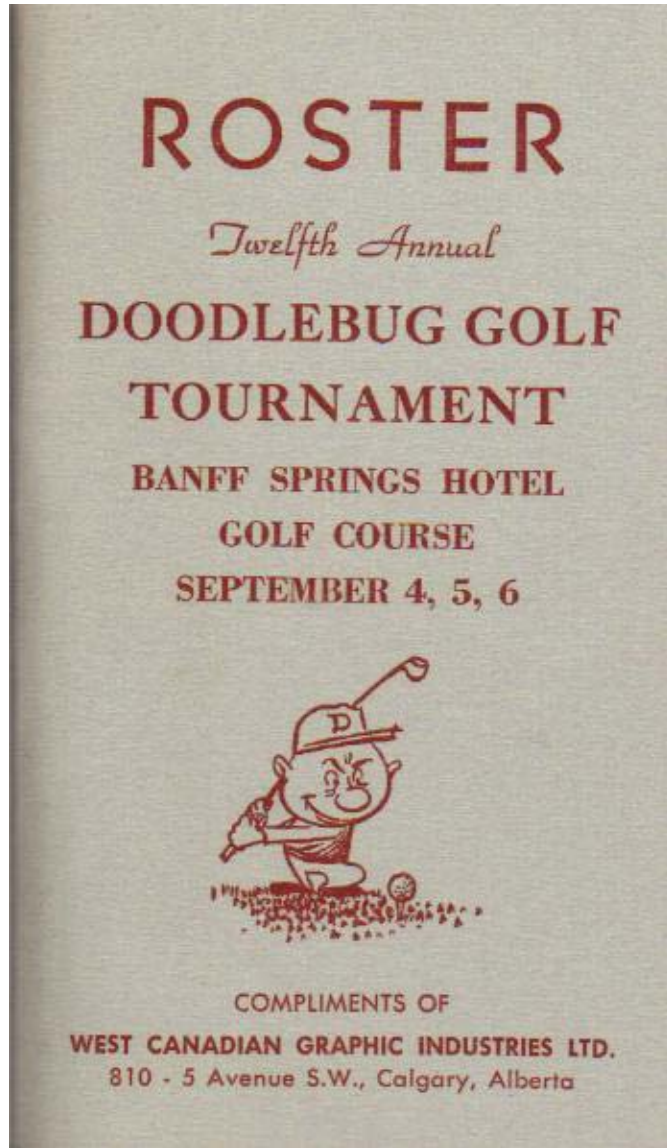
- Mitsue gas field discovered, BC

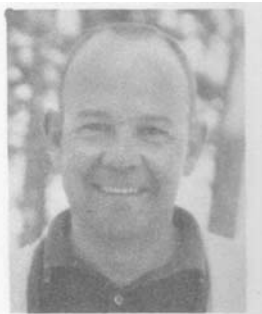

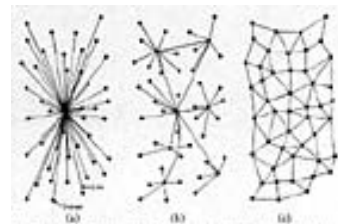


Fig. 1—(a) Centralized, (b) Decentralized, (c) Distributed networks.
