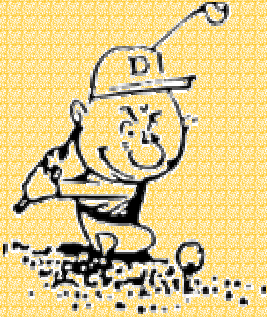

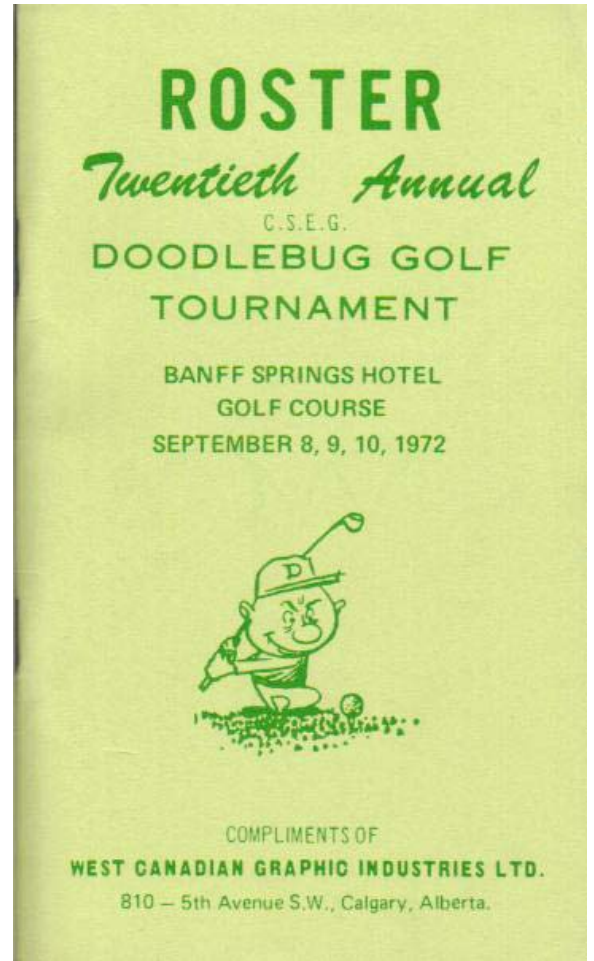

Pullen pulls off 20th Anniversary Doodlebug!

A historic milestone in the Doodlebug Golf Tournament's history was reached earlier this year, as the 20th anniversary of this popular event was held at the Banff Springs Hotel.

Mark Spitz wins 7 gold medals at the Munich Olympics. PLO terrorists get into the athletes' village, kill 2 Israeli athletes, and take 9 hostage.
