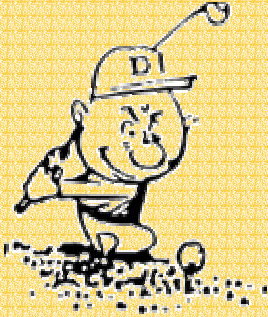

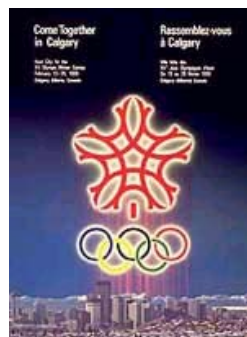
Oil patch activity in 1988:
